Through its commitment to market fundamentals, the Singapore model has received international recognition. The successful sale in 2008 of the three largest power generation companies by Temasek Holdings to private international investors illustrates the confidence investors have in the NEMS.

EMC is committed to training and education, conducting programmes for local and overseas industry participants and hosting delegations from around the world who are interested in learning about the NEMS. Utilising its extensive experience, EMC also assists other countries in Asia seeking to liberalise their electricity markets.

This year's Roundtable will cover an array of topics, including the role of the authority in the development of a competitive market, the benefits of integrating gas and electricity markets, and the prospects for nuclear power in ASEAN. There will also be an update on the European electricity markets, as well as a discussion on demand response in electricity markets.
